<p>As stated on pg. 6 of the ToR: "The evaluation should be completed within a timeframe of 2 months from the start of the consultancy," followed by "a preliminary intended timeframe of up to 24 days." In our estimation, the evaluation assignment will require well beyond the 24 days allotted but could be completed within the 2-month time frame. As such, and given the ToR reference to a 'preliminary intended time frame,' is MI suggesting that the 24 days is the entire LOE (for the entire team)? Or is there scope for a two-person team to work for up to 24 days each?</p>	<p>The 24 days are indeed the suggested total LOE for this assignment.</p>
<p>In the TOR, section "intended evaluation process &amp; expected reporting", you proposed including a survey with beneficiaries with sampling to be segregated by nationality, gender and geographical location. In order to draw an appropriate sample, we need the total population figure, the targets by nationality (Lebanese vs. Non-Lebanese) in each of the 11 targeted communities. Would you kindly share those figures?</p> <p>In the same section, you have also highlighted an expectation of FGDs with direct beneficiaries (individuals, SMEs). Would you kindly share the number of targeted SMEs in each implementing area?</p> <p>It would be very helpful in determining an appropriate scope if you can share an indicative budget range or a budget ceiling for this research?</p>	<p>The total target over the course of the project is 257,057 beneficiaries, split into the various components of the project (mostly health services, food distribution and agriculture support). Further details shall be shared and analysed during the inception phase of the assignment.</p> <p>The budget shall be part of the proposal of each applicant and will be assessed along with the rest of the proposal documents.</p>
